2021 AWARDS PROGRAM

THE OFFICIAL HANDBOOK OF THE APPALOOSA HORSE CLUB SHALL APPLY EXCEPT AS FOLLOWS:

SHOW POINTS

1. **SHOW APPROVAL/APPROVED SHOWS:** July Green Chile Classic with the Paint Club, August Red Chile Classic with Paint Club, and NM State Fair, if offered.
2. **POINT AWARDING SYSTEM:**

Year End Awards will be based on the following point system.

GRAND CHAMPION HALTER: To receive 2 points more than any in its sex division

RESERVE CHAMPION HALTER: To receive 1 point more than any in its sex division

The point system shall be as set forth in the NMApHC by-laws. If a show/judge is double pointed per ApHC Rules, it will be double pointed by NMApHC.

APPALOOSA QUALIFICATIONS

1. **HORSE** must be registered with the Appaloosa Horse Club, INC.; Moscow, ID. (ApHC)
2. **ALL OWNERS AND EXHIBITORS** must be members of the ApHC and NMApHC to qualify for Year End Awards. Only points earned as a member in good standing will count. Anyone may win an individual show award.
3. **MEMBERSHIP FEES AND THE MEMBERSHIP FORM** must be paid and filled out, respectively, before the first class of the first approved show in order for show points to count. Membership may be paid at an NMApHC approved show or by mail (prior to approved show). Fees may be paid at the show office or the Director of Membership.

CUMULATIVE AWARDS

Year End Overall High Point Awards will be awarded to the Horse with the most points.

1. **APPALOOSA OVERALL YEAR END** High Point Awards and requirements:

Award	Requirements
Open Western Performance Horse	1 halter class per show entered required: halter, color, hunter in hand, performance halter or ranch conformation (if eligible). Best <u>single</u> halter class per show will count toward award; cumulative points from all open western classes entered in approved NMApHC shows. Ranch classes, cattle, reining will not be included in this award.
Non-pro Western Performance Horse	1 halter class per show entered required: halter, color, hunter in hand, performance halter or ranch conformation (if eligible). Best <u>single</u> halter class per show will count toward award; cumulative points from all non-pro western classes entered in approved NMApHC shows. Ranch classes, cattle, reining will not be included in this award.
Open English Performance Horse	1 halter class per show entered required: halter, color, hunter in hand, performance halter or ranch conformation (if eligible). Best <u>single</u> halter class per show will count toward award; cumulative points from all open English classes entered in approved NMApHC shows.
Non-pro English Performance Horse	1 halter class per show entered required, including halter, color, hunter in hand, performance halter or ranch conformation if eligible; best <u>single</u> halter class per show will count toward award; cumulative points from all non-pro English classes entered in approved NMApHC shows.
Open Ranch Performance Horse	1 halter class per show entered required, including halter, color, hunter in hand, performance halter or ranch conformation if eligible; best <u>single</u> halter class per show will count toward award; cumulative points from all open ranch, reining AND cattle classes entered in approved NMApHC shows.
Non-pro Ranch Performance Horse	1 halter class per show entered required, including halter, color hunter in hand, performance halter or ranch conformation if eligible; best <u>single</u> halter class per show will count toward award; cumulative points from all non-pro ranch, reining AND cattle classes entered in NMApHC approved shows.
Open Halter Horse	Cumulative open halter points from all in-hand classes for which the horse is eligible over all NMApHC approved shows.
Non-pro Halter Horse	Cumulative non-pro halter points from all in-hand classes for which the horse is eligible over all NMApHC approved shows. Showmanship at halter does not count for this award, as it is a performance class.

Youth Horse	1 halter class per show entered required, including halter, color hunter in hand, performance halter or ranch conformation if eligible; best <u>single</u> halter class per show will count toward award; cumulative points from ALL youth classes entered in NMApHC approved shows.

2. APPALOOSA SHOW HIGH POINT AWARDS

- State Fair will give their own awards.

3. APPALOOSA SPECIAL AWARDS: Not offered in 2021

NMApHC Sportsmanship Award- Sponsored by _____ open to any age member of the NMApHC.

New Mexico High Point Open Versatility Horse Award (Bob Hickman Traveling Print): Appaloosa Horse and Owner must reside in NM. All points in Open Performance and Halter Divisions count. Horse must compete in all divisions. Divisions are: Halter (Halter, Hunter in Hand and Color), Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure, and Working. Anything not on the rail (Hunter Hack, Trail, Jumping, Ranch Riding, Ranch Reining, Working Cow, Western Riding, and Reining) is a Working division.

4. TIES:

In the event of a tie for the Overall High Point Award points accumulated in the following classes shall determine the winner.

HALTER: Grand and then Reserve points

ALL YOUTH: (in this order) Showmanship at Halter, Hunt Seat Equitation, Western Equitation/horsemanship.

NON PRO: (in this order) Showmanship at Halter, Hunt Seat Equitation (for English award) and Western Equitation/horsemanship (for Western Award).

OPEN: (in this order) for Western Award, Western Pleasure then Trail; For English award, Hunter Under Saddle, then Hunter in Hand.

RANCH HORSE: Ranch Riding, then Ranch Trail

7. WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW QUALIFYING: Not required for 2021

The top 5 Open horses and NonPro exhibitors will be qualified as a Regional Winner from the NMApHC. Winners will be determined by the total points earned in the time period as stated in the current ApHC Handbook. The highest pointing horse (and Non Pro) will be listed first and then the next and so forth. Only 5 horses and 5 Non Pros per class may be qualified thru Regional club nomination. Point will be tabulated only when member has a paid membership.

Member must be in good standing with both the National and the NMApHC to receive Regional nominations.
